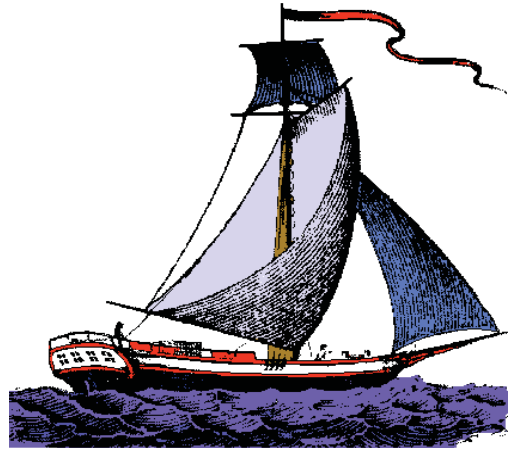


# LARRY
